Defenders of Wildlife is offering a 50% reimbursement toward the cost of an electric fence for securing grizzly bear attractants within the counties identified on the map. Maximum reimbursement is \$500. All fencing projects must meet minimum criteria listed in the Montana Electric Fence Guide for Bears (available at www.fwp.mt.gov or www.missoulabears.org or call for details). The program also offers technical expertise, along with design and materials recommendations specific to individual projects.


