

Governor Sarah Palin: Are you trying to stop Alaskans from voting?



Voters in Alaska have twice restricted aerial hunting by passing state ballot measures, only to have their efforts overturned by the Alaska legislature.

More than 56,000 Alaskans signed a petition to put aerial hunting of wolves and bears to a vote again on the ballot this August 26th.

Does your proposed legislation on this issue, now being aggressively pushed by some state legislators, intend to take away the opportunity for Alaskans to vote on this ballot measure?
